Roadworks

Little Hadham Post By-pass Works Phase 1

Dear Resident,

We are writing to tell you about works that we will be undertaking in your area.

We will be carrying out road-works outside the Little Hadham grocery store on the A120 Stortford Road. Works will include footway, bus stop lay-by works, installation of a signalised crossing point and improvement to gateway features on the four approaches to the village.

Works are programmed to commence on 4th April 2022 for 8 weeks. To create a safe working environment for the workforce and members of the public alike, the works will be carried out under temporary traffic signals which will remain in place 24/7. During this period there is the Easter break when the temporary traffic signals will remain on site. However, there will be a two-week period when the temporary signals will be removed for a public event and other essential highway works within area.

The gateway features work will be carried out under road closures, we will provide information boards on site to advise on the dates and timing of the closures.

Some degree of disruption and delay can be expected as a result of these works and whilst we will make every effort to minimise these, please allow extra time for any journeys you may make while these works are in progress. We greatly appreciate your patience and co-operation.

What you need to know:

- We would like to reassure residents that we are following Government advice relating to construction works and guidelines regarding social distancing to minimise the risks related to Covid-19 (Coronavirus).
- Please refer to the yellow signboards on your street to see the exact dates, timings, and permit number. Any date changes to these works will be communicated via these yellow signboards and at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/roadclosures
- These works are weather dependent and may be postponed if poor weather is forecast.

- Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works and all local businesses will be open as usual.
