9:30pm to 3pm at all other times.

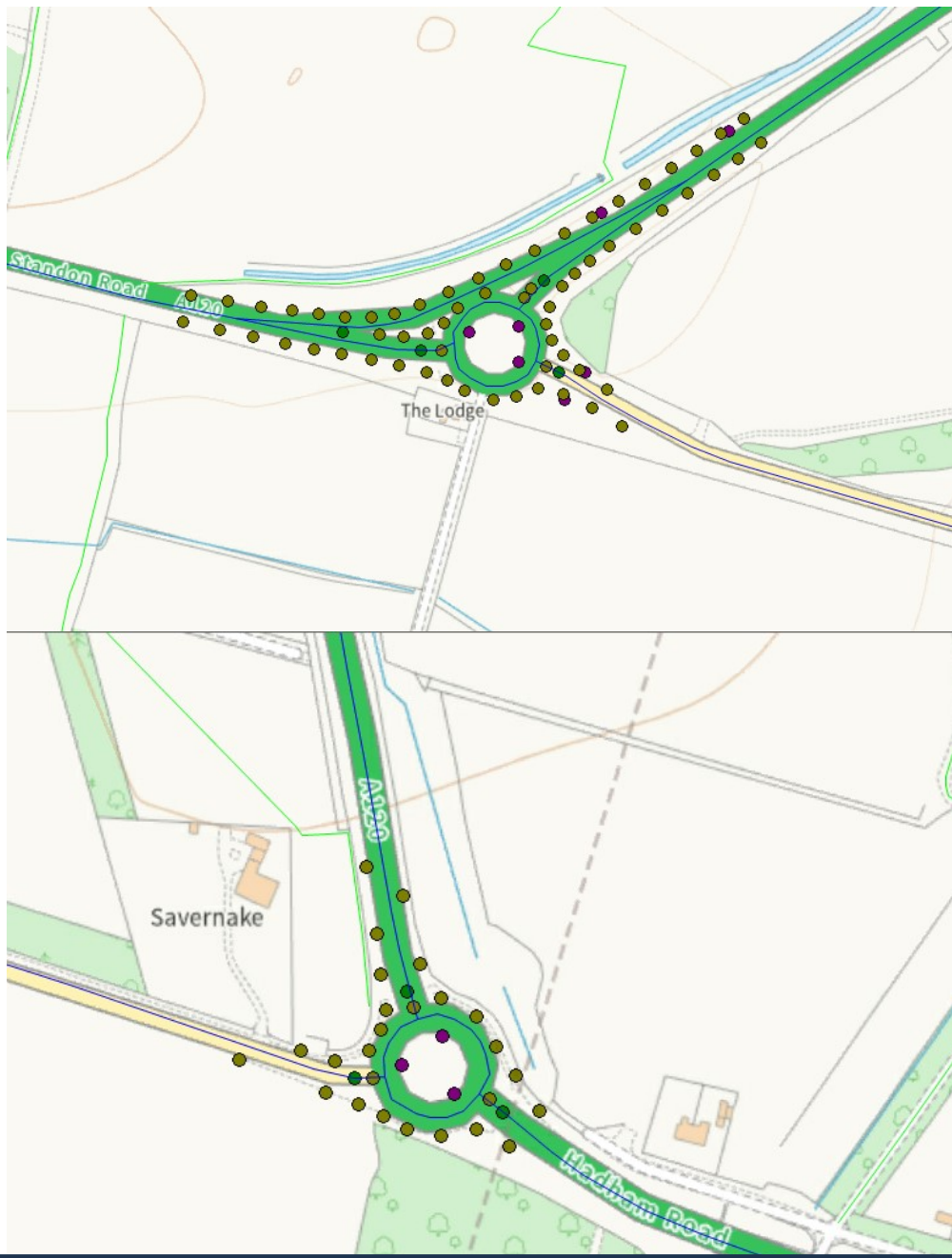
We are writing to tell you about works we'll be undertaking in your area.
